# Sight Word Activities

Write your words using rainbow colours	How many words can you fit into one sentence	Pick 3 words. Write 3 sentences	Play a game of memory	Play a game of snap	Play a game of Bingo

Rainbow words- Write each word using different colours for each letter. Alternatively write the word repeatedly in various colours.

Memory game- Write or type your words on cards. You will need 2 copies. Place the cards on the table. Turn over two cards. If they match you collect the cards. If not, flip them back over and try and remember their position for the next turn. Every time you flip a card, ensure you read the words aloud.

Bingo- Using the game board, write words in the spaces provided. Call out a word for children to locate and cover on their gameboard.

Coin toss words- Lay the word cards on the floor or table. Flip a coin. Read aloud the word that the coin lands on.

Floor find- Lay the cards on the floor facing upwards. Call out a word. Children need to find and stand on the word.

Chalk words- Use chalk to write the words outdoors.

Flashlight words- You will need a torch. Place words on a wall. Children shine the torch on a word and read aloud. Alternatively, you can say a word, and children flash the torch on the correct word.

Stepping stones- Lay cards on the floor to resemble a path. Children step on a card and recite the word aloud. Play again getting them to jump, hop, skip the path.

Word dollars- Calculate the total of each word by adding the value of each letter. Vowels \$2 Consonants \$1. E.g cat=\$1 + \$2 + \$1 = \$4

Mystery letters- Write each word, leaving some letters out. Cat= C\_.t. Children try and figure out each word.

Picture Words- Draw a picture, attempting to hide the words within various elements of the picture.

Magazine Words- Cut out letters from a magazine and paste them together to form words.

Build them with Blocks- Using blocks (Duplo or mega blocks work great) write a letter on each block. Children find the correct letters and join the blocks to form words.

Word Hunt- Hide words around the house. Children need to find them.
